Vinvita Prosecco, Veneto, IT, NV	8.5	38
<i>Wonderfully dry and crisp. Delicate bubbles with flavours of green apples and peach make this light on the palate and extremely quaffable!</i>		
Renard Barnier Cuvée Speciale Brut, Champagne, FR, NV	14	68
<i>This small family run Champagne house produces a beautiful Blanc de Noirs (50/50 Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier). Think red apple, quince and freshly baked biscuits. Rich on the palate with refreshing acidity.</i>		
Rathfinny Rosé Brut, East Sussex, EN, 2019		79
<i>Hailing from the chalky South Downs (which Rathfinny are helping to re-wild!) this silky textured rosé has notes of cranberry, cherry blossom and brioche – a perfect addition to our selection for the summer months.</i>

<b>CRISP &amp; MINERAL</b>		
Grüner Veltliner, Besas, Traisental, AU, 2022	11 / 15	42
<i>After a dry, white wine? Look no further. Austria's native white grape makes this fresh and crisp wine with flavours of green apple and pear, a hint of white pepper on the nose and a backbone of minerality.</i>		
Vinho Verde, Azevedo, PO, 2023		44
<i>Forget what you think you know about Vinho Verde, this decidedly modern example is a perfect wine to change your mind. Loureiro gives lime blossom and bay and Alvarinho brings ripe citrus and nectarine.</i>		
Côtes du Rhône Blanc, Grands Calcaires, Famille Gras, Rhône, FR, 2022		48
<i>A blend of typical Southern Rhône varieties, this wine is as rich in flavour as you'd expect from the region yet balanced by lively acidity and wonderful minerality. Think confit peaches, honeysuckle and lemon.</i>		
Riesling Trocken, Braunewell, Rheinhessen, GE, 2022		50
<i>Riesling has rather an unfair reputation. Often mistakenly believed to be a sweet wine this example is bone dry. Lime zest and juicy green apples with a slight salty tang on the finish – a perfect aperitif.</i>		
Albariño, Lagar de Costa, Rías Baixas, SP, 2023		58
<i>Family run winery, Lagar de Costa make wonderfully vibrant Albariño on Spain's Atlantic Coast. Lemon zest, grapefruit and ripe peaches, crisp acidity and a hint of salinity – one for Sauvignon Blanc fans!</i>		
<b>FRUITY &amp; FRESH</b>		
Vermentino, Les Vignes d'Eglise, Languedoc, FR, 2023	8 / 10.5	30
<i>Sometimes known as Rolle in the South of France, Vermentino is prized for producing aromatic, flavoursome yet refreshing whites. Notes of pineapple, mango and pear – a guaranteed crowd pleaser.</i>		
Dão Branco, Grão Vasco, PO, 2023		36
<i>One of Portugal's finest wine producing regions, the Dão creates whites of great aromatic depth and notable freshness. Intense aromas of pineapple, dried apricots and floral notes, fresh acidity and full-bodied.</i>		
Viognier, Domaine les Yeuses, Languedoc-Roussillon, FR, 2022	11 / 15	42
<i>Best known for the heady, aromatic wines of Condrieu in the Northern Rhône, this Viognier is incredibly fresh. Lots of stone fruit, wildflowers and honey, creamy textured yet fresh – peach yoghurt vibes!</i>		
Grillo, Rocce di Pietra Longa, Centopassi, Sicily, IT, 2022		52
<i>A sunshine wine made through the project of Libera Terra, Centopassi cultivates land confiscated from the mafia. Golden coloured with scents of yellow peaches, blanched hazelnuts and a hint of smoke.</i>		
Sancerre, Chavignol, Domaine Delaporte, Loire, FR, 2022		70
<i>One of the appellation's most impressive producers, the domaine has been passed down the Delaporte family since the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Wonderfully fresh and expressive Sauvignon Blanc – citrus tang with herbaceous notes.</i>

Old Vines Chenin Blanc, Kloof Street, Swartland, SA, 2022		52
<i>From Chris and Andrea of famed Mullineux wines, Kloof Street represents exceptional value. Concentration coming from the old vines, this Chenin is waxy and round from a touch of oak - baked pears and white peach.</i>		
Acústic Blanc, Acústic Cellar, Montsant, SP, 2022		58
<i>Working only with native varieties, Acústic Cellar express history and terroir through their wines. 30-70 year old vines provide concentration and complexity. Yellow plum, pear and ginger. Truly impressive, a must-try!</i>		
Mâcon Milly-Lamartine, Dom. la Pascette des Vignes, Burgundy, FR, 2021	15 / 21.5	60
<i>Winemaker Celine founded her domaine in 2013 and focuses on sustainable farming. A textured and sunny white from the Mâconnais, fermented and aged in old oak barrels to add richness to the wine.</i>		
Chablis, Nathalie et Gilles Fèvre, Burgundy, FR, 2021		65
<i>All the vines at this domaine are grown on the infamous Kimmeridgian limestone soils of Chablis. The resulting wines are fresh with ripe notes of pear and an unmistakable minerality – textbook Chablis.</i>		
Russian River Valley Chardonnay, De Loach, California, USA, 2021		70
<i>Burgundian winemaker, Jean-Claude Boisset acquired the De Loach estate in 2003. Combining the opulence of California with the elegance of a Burgundian approach. Rich and creamy – one for Meursault fans.</i>

<i>Promoting Spain's native grape variety (Monastrell) and working organically to produce this beautifully pale rosé. Delicate notes of strawberries and raspberries. A great match with summer sun...or ruin!</i>		
Cuvée Magali Rosé, Dom. Saint André de Figuière, Provence, FR, 2022	13.5 / 18.5	54
<i>Pure blue-sky drinking! Classically pale with subtle aromas of pink grapefruit, pomegranate and cherry blossom. Perfect for an aperitif but has enough body to pair beautifully with food.</i>

Côte de Brouilly, Les Grillés, Dom. Chevalier-Metrat, Beaujolais, FR 2022		46
<i>Not always seen as a serious wine, this Beaujolais producer is making wonderfully elegant and concentrated wines from old vines that showcase the region's textbook minerality. Redcurrants, raspberries and blueberries.</i>		
Pinot Noir, Enfant Rebelle, Antoine de la Farge, Loire, FR, 2022	12 / 17	48
<i>Antoine makes this wine with as little intervention as possible, aiming to make a fresh, crunchy Pinot Noir that's perfect for Summer. Oodles of bright red fruit and a hint of smoke – dangerously easy to finish a bottle!</i>		
Valpolicella Classico, Speri, Veneto, IT, 2022		48
<i>Another cracking summer red. Packed with flavours of ripe cherry and raspberry with hints of violet on the nose. Plush, supple and refreshing – would be absolutely delicious chilled (or heaven forbid with an ice cube or two!)</i>		
País, Vinista, Pedro Parra, Itata Valley, CH, 2019		54
<i>A variety you've never heard of from an unknown region in Chile...don't let that put you off! Vines of 120 years old make this gloriously light-bodied wine with minerality, a hint of spice and grip – not to be missed.</i>		
Chassagne Montrachet Rouge, Dom. Michel Niellon, Burgundy, FR, 2021		88
<i>Has the polish of a premium new-world Pinot with the old-world restraint of Burgundy. Notes of ripe red cherries, woodland strawberries, hints of leather alongside a touch of vanilla and smoke – utterly gorgeous.</i>

Nero d'Avola/Nerello Mascalese, Borgo Selene, Sicily, IT, 2022	8 / 10.5	30
<i>One of Italy's most influential winemakers, Alberto Antonini, plays a leading role in making this wine. Native Sicilian grape varieties produce a generous, soft red - black plums, spiced cherry and a hint of chocolate.</i>		
Douro Tinto, Esteva, Casa Ferreira, PO, 2022		38
<i>Famous for being the first producer in the region to focus on non-fortified wines this is a vibrant red with ripe cherries and plum, dark black fruit, floral notes and a hint of spice – a nice one for Côtes du Rhône drinkers.</i>		
Shiraz/Viognier, Willunga 100, McLaren Vale, AUS, 2020		42
<i>A nod to the traditional blend of Northern Rhône's Côte Rôtie. The Shiraz delivers a core of dark plum, black cherry, liquorice and spice while the touch of Viognier brings a vibrant and fragrant lift. Savoury and moreish.</i>		
Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Olivier & Lafont, Rhône, FR, 2021		45
<i>The next big name from the Rhône Valley!? Baptiste Olivier and Gerald Lafont have gained years of experience at some of the region's top estates and are now making negotiant wines that are getting people talking.</i>		
Menciá, La Premisa, Vinos Valtuille, Bierzo, SP, 2021	12.5 / 16.5	46
<i>One of the most exciting indigenous grapes to re-emerge from Spain in recent years. Fine boned and Pinot-esque with complex notes of sour cherry, pomegranate, black pepper and a granite-like minerality.</i>		
<b>BOLD &amp; FULL</b>		
Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Amoterra, Marche, IT, 2022		36
<i>'Amoterra', meaning love the land, perfectly sums up the organic and sustainable ethos of this winery. Blackberries, black cherry and a hint of sweet spice – a nice alternative for any Malbec fans out there</i>		
Corbières, Pierre Mignard, Château Fontarèche, Languedoc, FR, 2023	10 / 13.5	38
<i>Owned by the Mignard family since the 15<sup>th</sup> century, this estate produces excellent wines with a focus on sustainability. Dark and inky, black plum and strawberry compote, silky textured with a hint of chocolate.</i>		
Château Langlet, Graves, Bordeaux, FR, 2019		52
<i>Producing some of the best value wines from Graves. the Kressman family also own Château Latour-Martillac in neighbouring Pessac-Léognan. Merlot dominant. Red plums and cassis, fine tannins and supple texture.</i>		
Bodegas LAN, Rioja Reserva, SP, 2017		58
<i>Although a relatively new producer Bodegas LAN has gained an excellent reputation for quality wines. Classic Rioja - bold, powerful and velvet textured. Blackberry, fig jam, layers of sweet spice and vanilla.</i>		
Caburnio, Tenuta Monteti, Tuscany, IT, 2018		64
<i>This stellar Super Tuscan pays homage to the great reds of Bordeaux's Médoc whilst retaining an unmistakable Bolgheri character. Lush ripe berries and cherry, cranberry confit, subtle graphite nuances with hints of tobacco.</i>

<i>Delicate aromatics backed up by a rich and creamy palate - orange marmalade, white flowers and honey</i>
